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Birds ringed in Denmark and Iceland recorded in Italy

In relation to the demi-siècle jubilee of the scientific bird-ringing 1949 I have made state of the behaviour of DANSK ORNITHOLOGISK CENTRAL and find that we have ringed more than 200000 birds with my adress

About 12000 of them are recorded in Italy representing 16 danish and 1 Iceland species.

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In the following pages are given the detailed dates of all individues recorded in Italy, and beside are notet month for month the number of each species named recorded in other countries visited by them to give the full picture showing in which relation the italian records stands to the whole migration and to the other records.

Beside the name are noted how many individues ringed of the specie in question and how many records in total for the same specie.
